## **Boat Yard, Fuel Dock, Pump out Services**

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**Marine Servicenter** operates our full service boat yard and fuel dock at the Marina. Contact the **Marine Servicenter** professionals for all your repair needs. Boat yard office hours are from 8:00 to 4:30 Monday through Friday. Ask about their door to door haulout services for vessels in the Marina. Call **(360) 293-8200** during business hours to arrange for work estimates and get current fuel prices and quantity discounts.

The fuel dock summer hours begin on Friday May 27th. Holding tank pump out is also available for \$5.00 per vessel.

**Summer hours: 8 to 4:30 Mon - Thurs, 8 to 6 Fri, Sat, Sun**

## **Recycling and Proper Disposal of Hazardous Waste**

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The Marina has recycle bins located next to our trash dumpsters for recycled materials. Recycled materials include glass, plastic and cardboard. Large cardboard boxes should be placed alongside the dumpsters for removal by our crew. Only garbage should be deposited in the dumpsters. Hazardous waste must be disposed of properly. Marine Servicenter boat yard will take small quantities of motor oil and antifreeze for a nominal charge. Contact the Marina office for disposal of small quantities of paint and chemical cleaners from your dock box. Call Skagit County Hazardous Waste at (360) 424-3873 for disposal of larger quantities of chemicals including gas and diesel. They are located at 14104 Ovenell Road (heading on 20 eastbound, left at 2nd light east of the bridge then 1st right and on the right). Help us keep your Marina and your environment clean.

## **RV and Boat Trailer Parking.**

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**RV** parking is available at the Marina on a limited basis. RV parking must be approved in advance by the Marina office if the vehicle occupies more than one parking space. RV camping is not allowed by city zoning restrictions. Boat trailer parking is allowed only in the area provided (NW corner of the Marina). Write you name and slip number on the trailer tongue or the trailer may be disposed of as abandoned property. Improperly parked vehicles and trailers will be towed.

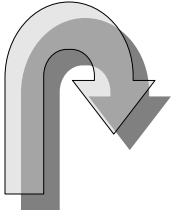
## **Pet peeves and protection**

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The Marina requires all pet owners to pickup after their pets. Pet stations are available at each driveway entrance to provide bags for this purpose. Pets must be kept on a leash when on Marina grounds. Please be aware that Marina wild life should not be approached. Small pet owners should also be aware that eagles may be flying overhead.

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## Vessel turn around Policy



The policy of the Marina is to allow a vessel the assigned slip size plus 2 feet. Your vessel, including the dinghy and all projections forward and aft, should not exceed this measurement.

**During the busy summer season (May through September), all vessels must be tied in their slip so as not to extend beyond the piling at the end of your finger pier.**

**IF** your vessel projects beyond the piling, turn your vessel bow in to the slip. **IF** your vessel still projects past the piling, see us at the Marina office for a larger slip assignment. Please make sure no part of your vessel extends over the main walkway to create a hazard for those walking on the dock.

### Children

Children 12 and under must always be accompanied by an adult at the Marina. We recommend children wear their life jackets at all times they are on the docks.

### Dock carts

Over 40 dock carts are available for your use at the Marina. Please return dock carts to the top of the ramp after you have unloaded them so they are available to others. Carts should not be used as work benches. **Do not overload your cart.** Dock ramps may be steep during Spring tides. The cart should always be on the down hill side of you. Lower the cart in front of you as you go down keeping a firm grasp on the hand rail. Pull the cart up behind you when climbing the ramp. Free tide books are available at the Marina office to help you coordinate your arrival and departures with the tides.

## Sublease your slip

The Marina is continuing its policy allowing tenants to sublease their slip. Tenants wishing to sublease their slip space should supply the Marina office with a completed Sublease Package (including proof of insurance), at least one week before the subleasing vessel is to arrive. A \$20 sublease administration fee will be billed to the slip tenant for each approved sublease. Other restrictions apply so please contact the Marina office for full details or to pickup a Sublease Package. Let us know if you will be cruising (1 month minimum) and want to make your slip available for a sublease.

## Liveaboard Policy at the Marina

Slip owners and tenants wishing to spend more than 30 days on board their vessel at the Marina must apply for a Liveaboard Permit at the Marina office. Liveaboard permit applicants must submit to additional inspections of their vessel and return **proof of pump-out** coupons to the Marina office on a monthly basis. The Marina limits liveaboard slips to 5% of total slips in the Marina. Contact the Marina office to check for current liveaboard slip availability.

## Wi-Fi Internet Access

Wireless web access is available at the Marina. Broadband Xpress (recently purchased by Beacon WI-FI) is offering wireless web access at your vessel for \$34.95 per month (12 month contract) or \$10.95 per day for short term use. ### Food Donations

Anacortes Marina is pleased to continue its support of the **Anacortes 100 Food Bank**. If you are cleaning house/boat or have food left over from a recent trip, you may drop off donations at the Marina office or place them in the bin located in the lobby of the Marina building.

### Parking Permits

Permit parking along the east fence is reserved for condo owners displaying parking stickers. Please limit your use of loading zones to no more than 30 minutes. You will be ticketed and may be towed if you abuse these rules. If you are going out for over 4 days, help us ease the congestion by parking in the north lot. Thank You.

### Crew Working

Strong disinfectants are used to clean our re-stroom facilities. Please allow our crew to complete their cleaning by using an alternate restroom.

**All Dock attachments (cleats, bumpers, etc.) must be approved in advance and installed by Marina staff.**

### BBQ Permit

By order of the Anacortes Fire Marshall, no fires of any kind are allowed in the Marina without a permit. BBQ permits are available at the Marina office for those who want to BBQ on their vessel.

**BBQs and crab cookers are never to be used on Marina docks.**
