## **Boatyard, Fuel Dock, Pump Out**

**Northwest Marine Center (previously Marine Servicenter)** operates a full service boatyard, fuel dock, and pump out at the Marina.

**Boatyard Office Hours:** Monday – Friday 8 to 4:30 Phone: 360-293-8200

**Fuel Dock Hours:** Mon – Fri 8 to 4:30. **Call the yard office for Weekend hours.**

## **Covid 19 Virus and Marina Operations**

As the Covid Virus emergency continues all visitors coming to the Marina need to continue to practice social distancing and wear a face covering when required. Restrooms require limited numbers to allow for distancing. We encourage you to wear a mask when distancing is not possible and wash your hands and use hand sanitizer and wipes. The Marina office remains closed to walk in traffic. Please use the walk-up window or drop box for your business. Marina staff are on hand Monday through Friday 8-5 and Saturday 10-12 and 1-3.

## **Marina Renewal Continues to Move Forward**

This October we plan to replace all open slips on B dock and 272' of breakwater wall. Replacement of the dock requires that all boats be removed from these slips for the month of October. Displaced B dock tenants will not be charged rent for October. B dock owners and tenants are being contacted with suggested options for alternate moorage during construction. Options include moorage at other marinas or hauling the vessel for annual maintenance at a local boat yard. If you are planning to be out of your slip for the month of October, contact our office about a possible sublease of your slip to a displaced B dock tenant.

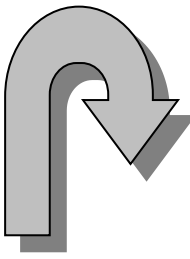
## **New Gates and Gangways**

Installation of new gates and ADA gangways at all docks is now completed. The new gates include a double magnet system which allows the gate to be held open for 30 seconds allowing you to get your cart through the gate before it releases. Access to the docks, restrooms, laundry and storage are now by key fob only.

Construction continues upland with the removal of the old gates and installation of a 5' wide plant strip along the fence line with paving and marking of car spaces to follow. We hope to have all work completed by June 1<sup>st</sup>.

## **Steel Key Exchange**

You should now return your steel keys to receive a credit against your two newly issued key fobs. Collect all your steel keys for a one stop return. Additional fobs are available for a \$10 charge. Keys must be returned by October 1<sup>st</sup> for credit.



Marina policy is to allow vessels their assigned slip size plus 2 feet. Your vessels **length overall** including your dinghy and all projections forward and aft, should not exceed this measure.

**During the busy summer season (May through September), all vessels must be tied in their slips so as not to extend beyond the piling at the end of the finger pier.**

**IF** your vessel projects beyond the piling, turn your vessel bow in to the slip. **IF** your vessel still projects past the piling see the Marina office for a larger slip assignment. Please make sure no part of your vessel extends over the main walkway creating a hazard for those walking on the dock.

**Is your child wearing a PFD?**

Children age 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult. We recommend children wear a PFD's at all times while on the docks. USCG requires children under 12 to wear PDFs while on small boats and when in an open cockpit. **Loaner PFDs are available in a variety of sizes at our office.**

**Dock Carts**

Over 40 dock carts are available. Please return carts to the top of the ramp when finished using them so they are available for others. Carts should not be used as work benches. **Do not overload your cart.** Ramps may be steep during Spring tides and the carts should always be in front of you as you go down the ramps keeping a firm grip on the hand rail. Tide books are available at our office to help you plan your visit.

**Sublease Your Slip**

Marina tenants are allowed to sublease their slips for up to 6 months. Tenants subleasing their slip space must complete a Sublease Package and supply proof of liability insurance for the subleasing vessel at least one week before the vessel arrives. A \$50 sublease administration fee will be billed to the slip tenant for each approved sublease. If you will be cruising for a month or more, we may be able to match you to someone wanting a slip at the Marina. All monies paid by the sub-lessee will be credited to your account. However, tenant will remain responsible for moorage fees. Call for more information and additional restrictions.

**Wi-Fi at the Marina**

Ecco Wireless provides a free Wi-Fi hot spot at the Marina. Additional service is offered for those who wish to pay for streaming options. **Dockside Pump out Provider**

**Sanitation Offloading Solutions, SOS** will pump out your vessel at the dock. The Marina is a **NO Discharge Zone**. Holding tanks and Porta-pottis must be pumped out at the fuel dock or by **Sanitation Offloading Solutions**. Call: 877.767.6862 for service.

**Pet Peeves and Protection**

Pet owners are required to pick up after their pets. Pet stations are located at each driveway entrance to supply bags for this purpose. Pets must be kept on a leash when on Marina grounds.

Wildlife on the docks should not be approached. Baby seals are often left alone while mothers go to feed and may be abandoned if touched. Owners of small pets should be aware that hungry eagles may be soaring overhead.

**Marina Security**

Pioneer Security is now patrolling Marina grounds after hours. You may be contacted by security personnel in the parking area or on the docks. Marina personnel are not available after 5:00pm. Please plan accordingly.

**For Police or Fire emergencies dial 911.**

**Parking**

Parking along the east fence is reserved for condo owners who display their current parking stickers.

Limit your use of loading zones to no more than 30 minutes. Vehicles left in unauthorized areas will be ticketed and may be towed.

**Marina Maintenance**

All dock attachments (cleats, bumpers, etc.) must be approved in advance and installed by the Marina staff.

Strong disinfectants are used when cleaning the marina facilities. Please allow our crew to finish their work by using an alternate restroom.

**BBQ Permits**

By order of the Anacortes Fire Marshall no fires of any kind are allowed in the Marina without a permit. BBQ permits are available at our office to allow for BBQ use on the vessel.

**BBQs & Crab Cookers are not allowed to be used on the docks.**
