

August 1, 2020 Construction Update

To Anacortes Marina E-Dock outside slip Tenants:

Replacement of docks and breakwater wall at the Marina is continuing this Fall as scheduled. We plan for the new dock construction to last 4 weeks beginning October 1st. **All Vessel owners will need to remove their boat from E dock by September 30th.** Moorage charges will be waived for the month of October. **As the Marina is full, you will need to investigate alternative moorage or storage options at other marinas and boat yards. Your dock box should now be empty so we can collect it for refurbishing.**

Boat Yard Storage Available:

North Harbor Diesel boatyard is offering a package plan again this year.

Haul and launch, normal pressure wash and October storage: 30' to 40' vessels \$675 plus electric.

Vessels hauled in September/launched in November will not incur additional costs for shortest storage. Vessel owners who contract with the yard for work to be done in excess of \$1,000 will have the storage portion of these costs waived. **If interested, contact North Harbor Diesel for a reservation. Storage spots with power and haul out dates for September are disappearing fast. Call now. (360) 293-5551.**

Marina Alternatives:

Cap Sante Marina Update: Space at the Port will be limited this year as they plan to replace A dock. **Some slips may be available for October depending on transient moorage needs and returning fishing boat fleet.**

If you want to be considered for moorage at Cap Sante during the construction, review the Port requirements and cost information below and then **contact the Port directly to make your reservation. Due to construction planning, the Port will not be taking reservations before September 1st.** Call (360) 293-0694. **Let our office know if you are interested in keeping your boat in the water at Cap Sante.**

1. Complete a Cap Sante Marina Application and Winter Moorage Agreement.
2. Provide a copy of your Vessel insurance with Cap Sante listed as Named Insured.
3. Complete the required Washington Revenue and abandoned vessel information sheet.
4. The monthly rate for vessels up to 30' \$303.25, up to 32' \$349.33, up to 40' \$469.02.
5. Plus \$3 environmental fee, plus \$12 for 1st 100kwh and .12 per kwh over 100.
6. Summer transient rates \$1.53 per foot, per day, will apply for early days in September.
7. Winter transient rates \$.97 per foot, per day, will apply for extra days in November.
