Anacortes Marina, Covid-19 Health Update

The situation with the Covid-19 virus outbreak changes almost daily. If Europe is a guide, we may be ordered by the State to “Shelter in Place”, or if one of our staff became ill, all other staff will need to self-quarantine. **Below is our tentative plan that will be implemented as required.**

A “Shelter in Place” order will remove all Marina personnel from the Marina grounds.

1. The Marina Office and Office building will be closed. Contact with Marina personnel will be by phone or email only. Marina staff will monitor email and phone and return messages.
2. North gate will be left secured and dock gates will continue to be secured.
3. Restrooms will be closed as they cannot be cleaned, supplied with paper or soap. You will need to use facilities on your vessel during this period. Pump out services may be available at MarineServicenter, Cap Sante Marina or SOS boat at 877-767-6862.
4. We do not anticipate interruption of City services of Water, Sewer, Trash or Recycling.
5. If you have the capability you may consider a two week cruise (or longer?) while we are locked down.

All should continue to sneeze/cough into arm or tissue, **wash your hands**, try not to touch your face and **practice social distancing**. Small things that can add up to keep you safe.

Stay tuned for additional notices regarding interruptions to our normal office hours and billing procedures should the Marina Office be closed for an extended period.
