B Dock Replacement Update

To All Anacortes Marina B Dock outside slip Owners and Tenants:

Replacement of our outside docks and the breakwater wall at the Marina will continue this Fall on schedule. For October 2021 we plan to replace all outside slips on B dock and replace 272' of the East breakwater wall. We plan for dock replacement construction to last 4 weeks beginning October 1st so vessel owners will need to remove their boat from B dock by September 30th. Tenants will not be charged rent for the month of October. As the Marina is full, you should investigate alternative moorage options at other marinas and boat yards.

**** Empty Your Dock Box: Please empty your dock box by September 1st. All boxes are to be sent away to be refurbished. Please notify the Marina office when your dock box is empty.**

Cap Sante Marina: Unfortunately, the Port of Anacortes has planned to be refurbishing Q, P and O docks this year and have told us that no moorage would be available for our displaced tenants.

Boat Yard Alternatives:

North Harbor Diesel boatyard is offering a package plan again this year.

Haul and launch, normal pressure wash and October storage: 40' to 50' vessels \$700 plus electric.

Vessels hauled in September/launched in November will not incur additional costs for shortest storage.

Vessel owners who contract with the yard for work to be done in excess of \$1,000 will have the storage

B Dock Electrical Testing:

Pedestals on the new docks are equipped with GFI breakers that will trip when an imbalance occurs in your shore power draw to the vessel. We will be testing each vessel before the new dock arrives and will alert boat owners that exceed the 30mA limit so they can plan for repairs to allow them to receive power from the dock. A passing test result will allow you to plug in without tripping the breaker but not assure all systems will work. If your vessel systems do not exceed the 30mA limit you will be welcome at any Marina with new equipment.

Please let the Marina Office know when you have a confirmed reservation at a boat yard or other Marina.
